

Requirements to take the Illinois Licensed Environmental Health Practitioner Examination:

First-Time Applicants:

This examination is a multi-step application process. You must first apply to the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation for approval prior to registering here to Continental Testing Services. You can apply to IDFPR at: <https://idfpr.illinois.gov/profs/envhlthpract.html>. Once approved by IDFPR, you will receive an approval letter instructing you to apply here to Continental Testing Services with a testing fee. You can apply to our office by registering online at the Licensed Environmental Health Practitioner Application on the previous page. Once you are approved by our office, we will notify the National Environmental Health Association of your eligibility. You will then receive an email authorization to test from Pearson Vue allowing you to register to take the examination. You will be able to schedule the examination at a location of your choosing at your convenience.

Retake Applicants:

You will need to reapply here to Continental Testing Services with payment in order to receive a new authorization to test. You are not required to reapply to the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation unless your application is over three years old.

ADA Applicants:

Environmental Health Practitioner – After approval to test has been issued by IDFPR and CTS, please request accommodations through NEHA directly - see website: NEHA Instructions - Accommodations, and email credentialing@neha.org to request ADA forms at least 8 weeks before the exam. Requests must be made to NEHA prior to registering for exam.
